

The 1st and 2nd digits stand for International Business Management (MI)

The 3<sup>rd</sup> digit is the year.

The No.1 is the 1st year.

The No.2 is the 2<sup>nd</sup> year.

The No.3 is the 3<sup>rd</sup> year.

The No.4 is the 4th year.

The 4th and 5th digits are the subgroups of the course.

The numbers 01-20 are the fundamental course.

The numbers 21-40 are the core courses.

The numbers 41-60 are the required major courses.

The numbers 61-80 are the Elective major courses.

The numbers 81-100 are the other courses.
