**3.1.1.2 Model 2.1** is an educational plan that emphasizes research by producing high quality dissertations and contribute to academic and professional progress and study courses ( Coursework) not less than 21 credits plus a dissertation of 36 credits. Total credits throughout the course is not less than 57 credits .

### **3.1.3 Courses in the curriculum**

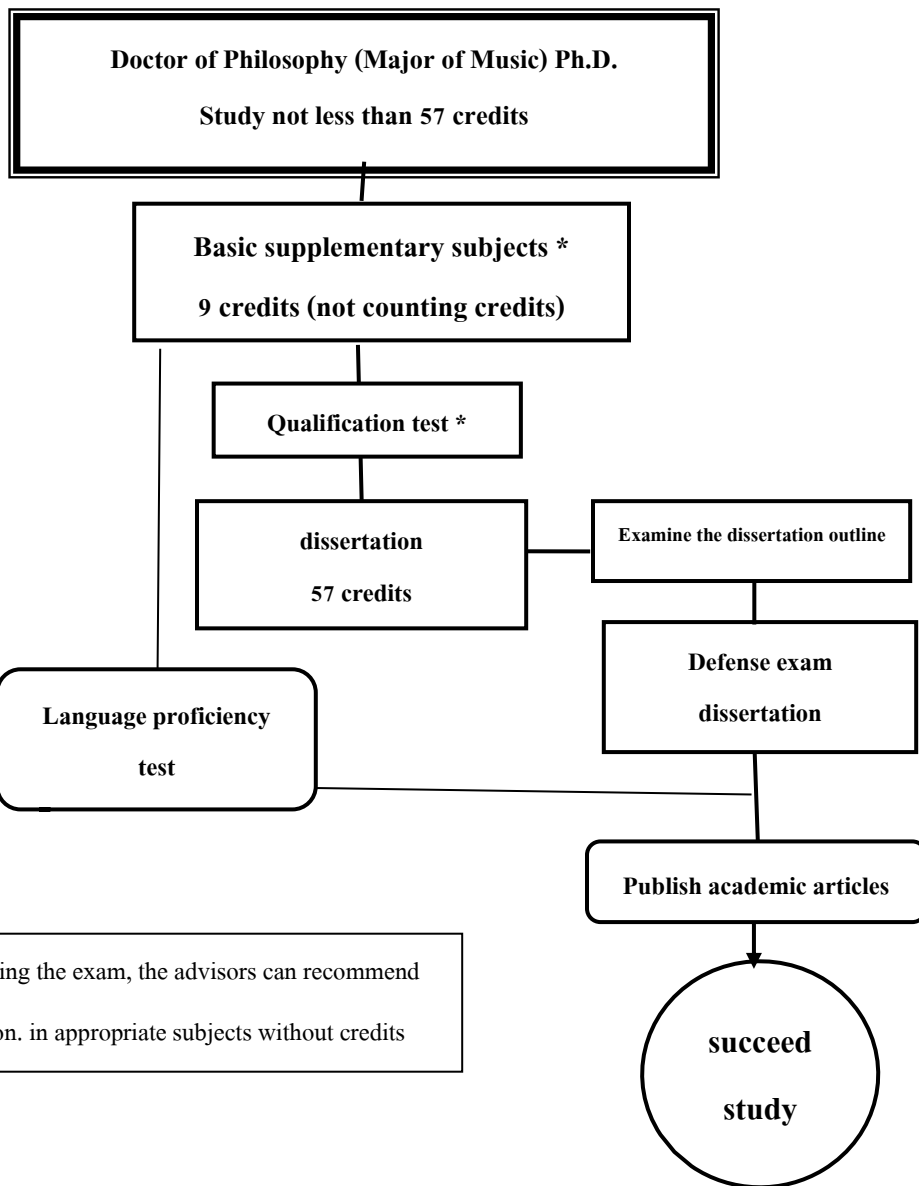

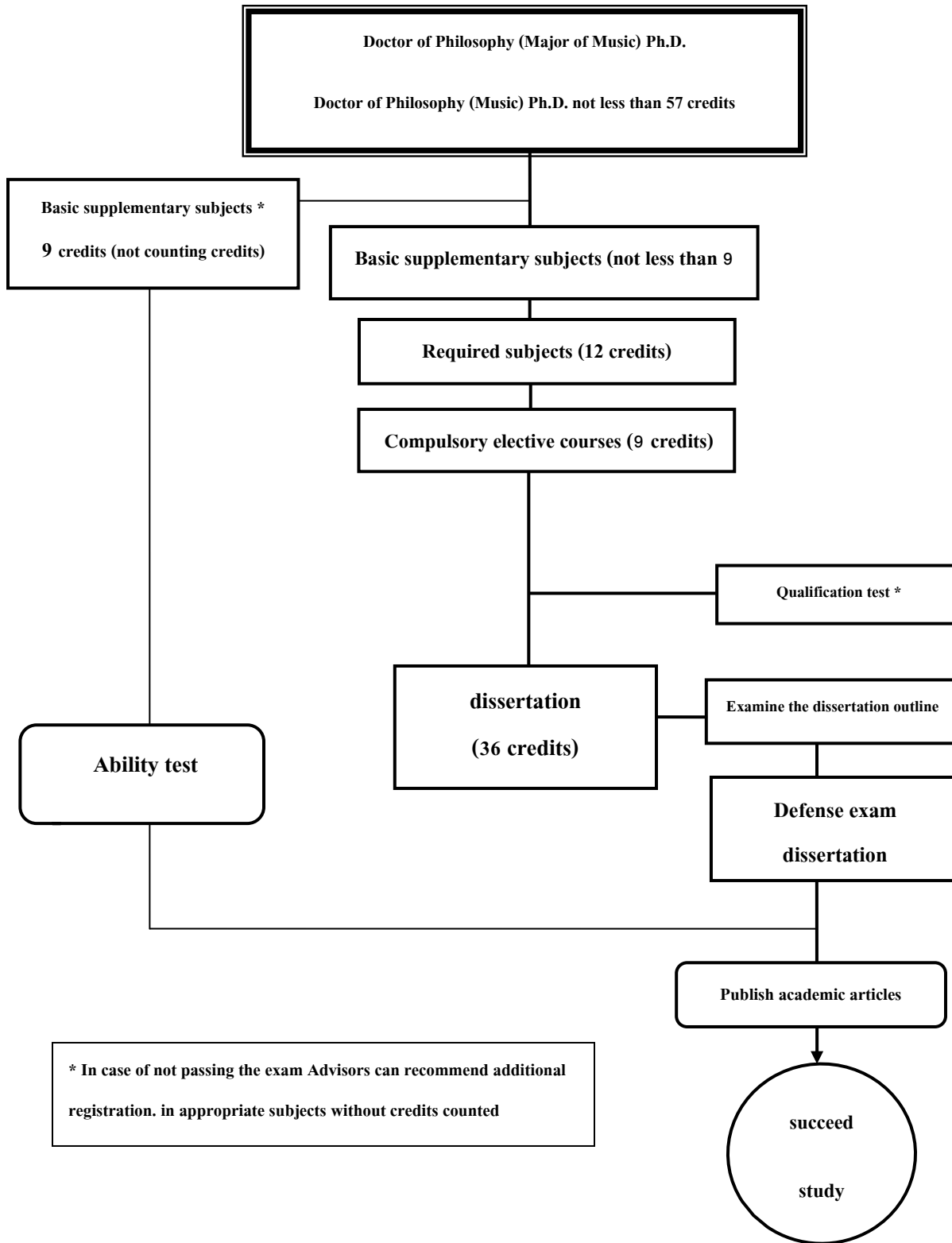
